Customer Information Swimming

- In the interest of safety one adult (person over the age of 16 or parent) must accompany up to a maximum of two children under the age of 8 years old.
- All children under 8 years must be supervised in the pool, on poolside and within the centre by a responsible adult or parent at all times.
- Please ensure that all weak and non-swimmers have appropriate floatation aids, please note that the facility does not lend out equipment however resalable goods are available to purchase from reception. Large inflatable's, flippers and masks are not permitted.
- In order to help with health and hygiene standards we would ask that all users wear overshoes provided when entering the changing rooms or pool area. Outdoor shoes and pushchairs are not permitted on poolside or within the changing rooms.
- We advise you that lane ropes are put in & out of the pool during some sessions, our Lifeguards will inform you & ask for your co-operation
- During busy periods, restricted sessions may operate. You will be given a coloured wrist band to indicate when you should leave the pool.
- Please take lifeguard's advice and refrain from unruly behaviour for your own safety and safety of others.
- Please do not get changed or change children in the public spectator areas.
- Please do not enter the pool before the start of the session.
- Please note you will be asked to leave the pool at the end of each session unless otherwise indicated on the timetable.
